In preparation for Rosh Hashanah, we hear the sounding of the ram's horn shofar each weekday.

We recite Psalm 27 at the end of the morning and afternoon

(Tishnei 21)—a total of 50 days.

• The Baal Shem Tov instituted the custom of reciting three additional chapters of Pialms each day, from Rosh Chodesh Bull until Yorn Kippur. On Yorn Kippur the remaining 36 chapters are sorted correlation the certics head of Pialms.

 Elul is the time to have one's telfilin and mezuzot checked by an accredited scribe to ensure that they are in good condition and fit for use.

Rosin Hashmash celebrates the beginning of creation. On this day, G-d charged Adam with the responsibility of helping the world reach perfection. Rosh Hashmash, therefore a time for us to reflect on the purpose of creation and resolve to make our lives more meaningful by contributing to all of creation.

The Shofar: On Rosh Hashanah we hear the sounding of the shotar, the ram's horn: It is the oldest and most soutful of wind instruments, sounding like a primal outcry from the depth of the soul. Its blasts signify our proclamation of G-da King of the universe and awaken us to repent and esturn

Tashlich: On the first afternoon of Rosh Hashanah it is customary to visit a natural body of water that contains fish. There we recite a short prayer and "cast" our past sins down the river of time.

first meal of Rosh Hashanah symbolizes the hope that our new year be blessed with sweetness and goodness. For the same reason, it is customary to eat other sweet foods, such as taimmes.
